~ Synopsis ~



The Son of His Majesty The Mikado, Nanki-Poo, moved to Titipu a year ago to avoid marrying an elderly, ugly lady of his father's Court and so joined the Titipu Town Band disguised as a Second Trombone. He fell madly in love with Yum-Yum and she with him. Unfortunately, Yum-Yum was betrothed to her guardian Ko-Ko, the local tailor and so Nanki-Poo left town.

A month ago, Nanki-Poo received word that Ko-Ko had been condemned to death for flirting so he resolved to find Yum-Yum. On his return, Nanki-Poo is told by Pish-Tush, a Noble Lord of Titipu that Ko-Ko was reprieved at the last moment and exalted to the highest rank a citizen can attain - Lord High Executioner.

Pooh-Bah, now Lord High Everything Else, having taken on all the posts of the local dignitaries who didn't want to work under an ex-tailor, proceeds to give Ko-Ko some rather conflicting advice on how much money the State is willing to spend on his wedding.

Yum-Yum, her sisters (Pitti-Sing and Peep-Bo) and her friends return from school and Pooh-Bah is bribed by Ko-Ko to be nice to them; the girls, however, find it all hilarious and then have to apologise for being rude. Yum-Yum and Nanki-Poo are reunited and are just as in love as they were a year ago; Nanki-Poo reveals to her his true identity, they discuss how happy they might be and what they would get up to if she were not engaged to Ko-Ko and if flirting were not against the law. They leave each other, realising the hopelessness of their situation just as a letter arrives for Ko-Ko from The Mikado. The Mikado insists that an execution must take place as it has been a year since the last one, otherwise the Town of Titipu will be reduced to the rank of a Village. Ko-Ko, Pooh-Bah and Pish-Tush debate the issue – either, one of them dies, or, they find a substitute.

Nanki-Poo, now aware that he will never be able to marry Yum-Yum decides to commit suicide; Ko-Ko, seeing him attempt this, realises that he has found his substitute. Nanki-Poo agrees to be beheaded in a month, providing that he can marry Yum-Yum. This plan pleases the locals and they begin the celebrations. They're all having a great time until the aforementioned elderly, ugly lady, Katisha, turns up and frightens everyone. She attempts to tell the locals who Nanki-Poo really is but Yum-Yum and her sisters manage to keep it a secret, Pitti-Sing makes fun of Katisha who is forced to leave for reinforcements.

As Yum-Yum prepares for her wedding, her sisters tease her about her marriage plans being 'cut short'. The girls, along with Nanki-Poo and Pish-Tush, try to convince themselves that everything will be fine. Unfortunately, Ko-Ko then reveals that when a married man is beheaded his wife is buried alive; needless to say Yum-Yum isn't best pleased and the wedding is off!

The Mikado approaches the town and Ko-Ko decides that an execution needs to be arranged quickly. Nanki-Poo, now distraught at losing Yum-Yum again, swiftly volunteers but Ko-Ko admits that he isn't quite ready to perform his duty as Executioner and decides to bribe all the local officials instead (namely, Pooh-Bah) so they will swear to any story. Ko-Ko tells Nanki-Poo to go and marry Yum-Yum and leave Titipu for good; this allows Ko-Ko, Pooh-Bah and Pitti-Sing to come up with a very tall tale about how the execution took place; they relay this tale to The Mikado and Katisha on their arrival.

The Mikado reveals that he didn't come about the execution after all but came looking for his Son, Nanki-Poo. Only then do the three fibbers realise the consequences of the story they have just told and The Mikado is only too happy to tell them the punishment for encompassing the death of the Heir Apparent. As The Mikado takes a break for lunch, it's decided that the only way to save their lives is if Ko-Ko persuades Katisha to marry him, he's not too pleased but reluctantly agrees.

Katisha, now lonely and forelorn, is an easy target for Ko-Ko who spins her a yarn about how he loves her; Katisha falls for it and marries him. Katisha introduces her new husband to The Mikado and begs forgiveness for him and his friends; The Mikado, however, is still not too pleased that his Son is dead. Just in time, Nanki-Poo arrives and reveals he is not dead but is now married; Katisha realises she has been tricked.

Ko-Ko, yet again, manages to talk his way out of a sticky situation and The Mikado finds his explanation most satisfactory. With Pitti-Sing leading the way, everyone joins in the celebrations.


